Regulation sheet – Chemical products

The purpose of this regulatory fact sheet is to detail Essilor's minimum requirements in terms of the industrial standards and regulations with which the Supplier undertakes to comply when supplying Products, in accordance with Essilor's General Terms and Conditions of Purchase. In all cases Supplier undertakes to comply with all industrial standards and regulations applicable to the Products, even where not listed in this fact sheet.

This fact sheet may be revised by Essilor at any time, most notably following legislative or regulatory changes.

Supplier guarantees that the substances delivered which are covered by REACH regulation 1907/2006 have been duly preregistered in the period 1 June to 30 November 2008.

Supplier guarantees the availability of the individual preregistration number, which it undertakes to provide at Essilor's request.

Supplier guarantees to Essilor that the substances delivered which are covered by CLP regulation 1272/2008 have been duly notified prior to the final legal date for CLP notification.

Supplier is under an obligation to provide a Safety Datasheet (compliant with REACH regulation 1907/2006) for the substance or preparation delivered for:

- a substance or preparation classified as hazardous under CLP regulation 1272/2008,
- a PBT – Persistent, Bioaccumulative and Toxic – substance or a vPvB – Very Persistent, Bioaccumulative and Toxic – substance as defined by REACH regulation 1907/2006,
- a substance included on the Candidate List for authorization under REACH regulation 1907/2006,
- a preparation not classified as hazardous under CLP regulation 1272/2008 and which contains:
 - either $\geq 1\%$ weight by weight as a ratio to total weight in the preparation of a substance classified as hazardous under CLP regulation 1272/2008 (0.2% by volume in the case of a gas),
 - or $\geq 0.1\%$ weight by weight as a ratio to total weight in the preparation of a PBT – Persistent, Bioaccumulative and Toxic – substance or a vPvB – Very Persistent, Bioaccumulative and Toxic – substance or a candidate for authorization as defined by REACH regulation 1907/2006.

The Safety Datasheet (compliant with REACH regulation 1907/2006) shall be in the English and French languages at least and in any other additional languages stipulated by Essilor as corresponding to the various countries in which the substance or preparation delivered is to be used.

In the event of a decision not to register any of the preregistered substances Supplier shall be under an obligation to notify Essilor at least six months prior to the final legal date for such registration.

In the event of a decision to cease commercialization of the substance or preparation delivered, Supplier shall inform Essilor six months prior to the date of such cessation.

Supplier is under an obligation to register the identified uses notified to it by Essilor. If registration is not the responsibility of Supplier, the latter is under an obligation to notify to its own suppliers the identified uses notified by Essilor.

Supplier undertakes to supply substances that have been duly authorized for the uses identified by Essilor where those substances are listed in Annex XIV of REACH regulation 1907/2006. To that end, Supplier shall use the Safety Datasheet to notify the authorization number.

Supplier undertakes to supply Essilor with substances and preparations that meet restriction requirements where those substances are listed in Annex XVII of REACH regulation 1907/2006.

In the event of a decision to modify the composition of a preparation, most notably following adoption of regulatory provisions requiring authorization or restriction for any of the substances making up the preparation, Supplier shall inform Essilor 30 days prior to the implementation of the change. Supplier shall communicate to Essilor the elements listed above as modified following the change to Product composition.

In case of problems of interpretation between any of the headings appearing above the clauses and any of the corresponding clauses, the headings shall be considered as non-existent.
